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TOPICS

The Louisiana Workers' Compensation Educational Conference will feature general sessions and workshops that focus on the significant changes that are occurring in workers' compensation in Louisiana as well as common questions affecting the workers' compensation system. The most significant shift is the adoption of evidence-based medical treatment guidelines and the new dispute resolution process that will help address disputes over medical treatment. Other topics will include Utilization Review, E-Billing, and Hearing Rules. The conference also will highlight new and enhanced services of the Louisiana Office of Workers' Compensation Administration (OWCA), discuss how these relate to the mission of the Louisiana Workforce Commission, and lay out plans for the future. The presenters will be senior officials of the OWCA and other experts.
